April Class Descriptions

Ages & Stages- These are questionnaires that give an effective and affordable way to systematically screen infants and young children for developmental and social-emotional delays in the crucial early years of life. Come and learn some of the age-appropriate skills you can introduce to your child. Call 870-9583 to schedule your session.

Along Came a Spider- Lure children into a web of wonder as they participate in spider activities for preschool. Through storytelling, movement, web weaving, and crafts, children will learn about this amazing and helpful creature. This class is taught by Miss Stephanie and Miss Crystal.

Backwards Day- Forget everything you know and join us for a silly day of backwards activities! We will have movement, crafts, and lots of backward learning fun. And don't forget to dress the part- wear your clothes backwards for a special prize! Taught by Miss Stephanie.

Broom, Broom! -Join us for a fun hour filled with car block play activities matching, sorting, while have fun with the concepts of same and different, problem solving with manipulative to engage children through play while working on fine motor skills as we get ready for our Touch a Truck weekend activities. This class will be led by Miss Stefanae.

Busy Parents on the Move- Being a parent is not always easy. However, we find ways to make everything work out just fine. In this class we will develop topics of interest and struggle to discuss. We will share with other parents; learn new things, gain new resources, ideas, and strategies to help us continue to manage all we do. This discussion group will be led by Miss Cam.

CCSD FACES Presents: Start with a Book-Our FACES staff will start with a book for an exciting read aloud, followed by hands-on activities and real-world explorations that stretch the imagination, build problem-solving skills, and help strengthen a child's vocabulary and knowledge of the world. It is designed to build on what young children (ages 3-5) already like — dinosaurs, building, animals, sports, superheroes and music — so that parents, can have fun and interact meaningfully with children while helping to strengthen their reading skills.

Child Safety with UNR Cooperative Extension- This the four-week Child Safety and Welfare program. Topics include: Shaken Baby Syndrome; Child Abuse Awareness; Anger Management; and Positive Guidance. The program offers a parent-child activity for each class and a book. The program is designed to improve awareness of important child safety issues and increase parenting knowledge. Join UNR Cooperative Extension as they lead this safety workshop.

Craft Class with Mireya- Come to this fun filled class that will be lots of fun creating crafts.. Your child will design, create, and enjoy making crafts prepared by our parent volunteer Mireya.

Craft Class with Emma- Come to this fun filled class that will be lots of fun creating crafts.. Your child will design, create, and enjoy making crafts prepared by our parent volunteer Emma.

Dancing with Miss Jenny® - Dancing With Miss Jenny® is a creative movement program designed to aid preschool aged children with and without disabilities achieve developmental milestones. Miss Jenny's concepts are a fusion of early childhood education, dance, and creative movement concepts choreographed to strengthen physical and mental advancements in young children. Common household and classroom items such as paper plates and plastic spoons are incorporated into the choreography to assist in bringing out the desired movements of the child, as well as provide a novel way to maintain their attention. Each piece of choreography targets a combination of developmental benchmarks such as gross and fine motor skills, sensory, cognitive, language and social skills.

Earth Day Fun with Erin- Come to this fun filled class that will be lots of fun creating Earth Day crafts. Your child will learn what Earth Day is all about. Your child will participate in fun activities prepared by our parent volunteer Erin.

Emergency Preparedness- It's very easy to panic during an emergency; being mentally and physically prepared may help to minimize that feeling of panic and enable you to keep your family calm, cool, collected, and most importantly, safe. Come and learn how to create an emergency preparedness plan including a disaster supply kit, as well as any emergency essentials.

Family Day at the Park- The weather is nice and the time is now! Let's get some fresh air and enjoy our morning outdoors at the park. We will have circle time, kids can enjoy gross motor fun, play with friends, and parents can socialize. Parents are welcome to bring food we will have a sign-up sheet for our snack/lunch time at the park!! Don't miss out on this fun day at the park! Five Little Speckled Frogs-Come sit on a Lily pad with me for finger play story time as we learn about the life of a Frog. This class will be led by Miss Stefanae.

Insect Shape Fun! -Sign up for fun class as colors and shapes class as we turn our shapes into Spring insects. In this class we will teach color and shapes recognition. This class will be led by Miss Stefanae.

International Children's Book Day- Join this fun class as children will get to bring their favorite book to share with their friends. Parents will also get to share why they love reading to their children. Children will get to make a special craft using their favorite book.

Pre K Readiness - Early learning and literacy is a key and much needed component to every child's start of education. This is an hour long class that will introduce and review the basics in Pre-K and Kindergarten.
