May Class Descriptions

Ask a Pediatrician from UNR School of Medicine - A Children's Health topic will be presented from a Pediatric Resident Physician from the University of Nevada Reno School of Medicine. Topics change each week and covers a range of issues including Child Car Seats, Nutrition, Obesity, Vaccines, Breastfeeding, Smoking Dangers, and much more. The presentation will be followed by a brief Q&A session where you can ask the Pediatrician any questions about their presentation or anything else about your child's health.

Busy Parents on the Move - Being a parent is not always easy. However, we find ways to make everything work out just fine. In this class we will develop topics of interest and struggle to discuss. We will share with other parents; learn new things, gain new resources, ideas, and strategies to help us continue to manage all we do. This discussion group will be led by Miss Chris.

Developmental Activities - This class begins with circle time where we sing favorite songs like 'Itsy Bitsy Spider' and 'Wheels on the Bus.' After circle time we enjoy several play activities which foster development in varying combinations of the following: development of fine or gross motor skills, transitioning, taking turns, sharing, and imaginative play. Class ends with parachute activities, bubbles and a goodbye song.

Explore and Learn with NEIS - These activities classes are facilitated and taught by developmental specialists with Nevada Early Intervention Services. There will be specialists available to answer your questions as well as to provide important information regarding your child's development.

Family Day at the Park - The weather is nice and the time is now! Let's get some fresh air and enjoy our morning outdoors at the park. We will have circle time, kids can enjoy gross motor fun, play with friends, and parents can socialize. Parents are welcome to bring food we will have a sign-up sheet for our snack/lunch time at the park!! Don't miss out on this fun day at the park! Family Story Time - Reading to your child at an early age is one essential gift that will prepare them for a great start in learning. Families can take this opportunity to get cozy and comfy in our center and read to and with their little ones. There will be activities for families to participate in with their little ones

Fine Motor and Manipulative Play - In this class we will explore and play with manipulatives and fine motor activities to strengthen those little muscles in our fingers and hands.

Gross Motor Fun! - Join us for a class filled with jumping, climbing, moving, and tossing! We will work our large muscle groups through play, movement, and music. This class will be led by Miss Melissa.

Imagination Station: Play Time in the Kitchen - Pretend play is an important aspect of development for children. In this class, we will access their imagination and pretend play skills as we pretend in the kitchen! Children will have opportunities to use everyday kitchen items, such as whisks and tongs, as well as "cook" in our kitchen station. This class will be led by Melissa.

Jump, Jump, Jump - This class is designed for toddlers who are already walking. The purpose of the class is to provide opportunity for physical activity and fun which promotes large muscle development and exercises coordination and balance. PARENT PARTICIPATION AND CLOSE SUPERVISION IS MANDATORY FOR THIS CLASS!!!

Learning Fun with The Children's Cabinet - Come join us to have fun with your little ones and be engaged in fun and developmentally appropriate activities. This hands-on informational class will offer some activities to help facilitate pre-kindergarten skills at home. Each class will be unique and cover a different theme. This class will be led by Carolina Cajica with the Children's Cabinet.

Mother's Day Celebration - Join us as we celebrate the special moms and grandmas in our lives! In this class we will take time to pamper ourselves, as well as do a craft to show our moms how much we love them!

Music, Music, Music - Join Elmo and friends as we learn with music. We will sing, dance, and make our very own a musical instrument.

"Nothing But Net" for Peewees - This ball-themed class is sure to please all our peewee friends! We will have a variety of gross and fine motor activities that involve using all sorts of balls.

Play, Learn & Grow! - This class will be lots of great family fun for children from birth to age five. We will have a fun craft and other fun developmental activities for toddlers to do. Bring your baby and diaper bag packed with a blanket so your little one can enjoy some tummy time, pre-walking, and socialization fun with other moms and their little one. This class will be led by F2F staff.

Positively Kids Playgroup - Join staff from Positively Kids for this fun and interactive play group that focuses on socializing, while increasing language skills, gross motor skills, fine motor skills, and cognitive development.

Pre K Readiness - Early learning and literacy is a key and much needed component to every child's start of education. This is an hour long class that will introduce and review the basics in Pre-K and Kindergarten. We will work on writing and recognizing our colors, shapes, letters, learning sounds, writing numbers, and learning beginning math concepts, number recognition, as well as focusing on development of fine motor, self-help and social/emotional skills. We will have related stories and crafts that will be in relation to lesson/theme focused on the week/month. The structure of the class will vary week by week depending on what we are doing and learning about. This class will be led by F2F staff.

Prince & Princess Day - Hear Ye, hear ye, call ye all little prince and princesses! This royal play, learn and grow class will feature some of our favorite prince and princess characters. No ball will be complete without a make and take crown-making activity, so come dressed for the ball and be ready to dance and have fun!

Sensory Play - Join us on a fun-filled day exploring with our senses. We will be using our hands and various objects to play with our sensory bins and other textured objects. This is a great way to explore different consistencies and textures with your child. This class will be led by Ms. Melissa.

Snack Time - We will provide your child with a snack to enjoy while they visit with other Family to Family friends. Parents can also feel free to bring your own snack during this time. All donations are appreciated.

Star Wars Fun! - It's Star Wars Day so have some fun we will have with this themed class! We will have several play activities that foster development in fine and gross motor, imaginative and sensory play. May the 4th be with you!
