








May Class Descriptions

Aerobic Fun for Kids- Let's get our hearts pumping and move to the beat!!! We will get fit with our F2F friends through this parent and child activity class that will be fun and help your little ones be happy to be fit. This class will be led by Cambria and Crystal.

All About Insects- Let's explore BUGS!!! We will make crafts, sing songs, and watch short video on insects. We will learn where bugs live and what they eat. This class will be led by Miss. Cam and Miss Crystal.

All About Plants- Let's get our hands dirty and plant some seeds. We will make crafts, sing songs, and watch short video on how plants grow. We will learn how things grow and make our own classroom garden. This class will be led by Miss. Cam and Miss Crystal.

All About Nature- Let's explore things that are from mother Nature!!! We will touch dirt, see animals, and learn about nature. We will make crafts, sing songs, and watch short video on nature. This class will be led by Miss. Cam and Miss Crystal.

Amazing World of Fruits and Vegetables- Fruits and veggies are yummy. Let's do crafts learn the importance of eating healthy. We will also have a **yummy** healthy snack we will create and enjoy. This class will be led by F2F staff.

Ages & Stages- These are questionnaires that give an effective and affordable way to systematically screen infants and young children for developmental and social-emotional delays in the crucial early years of life. Come and learn some of the age-appropriate skills you can introduce to your child. Call 870-9583 to schedule your session.

Busy Parents on the Move- Being a parent is not always easy. However, we find ways to make everything work out just fine. In this class we will develop topics of interest and struggle to discuss. We will share with other parents; learn new things, gain new resources, ideas, and strategies to help us continue to manage all we do. This discussion group will be led by Cambria.

Breastfeeding Support and Mixer for Moms – Pack the diaper bag and come on out to meet other moms and their babies!!! Get valuable information and support for breastfeeding and get any questions you may have answered by Nurse Susan Maurer, RN, BS, CLE, who will be leading this class.

C & C Science Factory! - Join us as we do various experiments as well as get our hands dirty during this STEAM driven class. This class will be led by Ms. Crystal and Miss Cam.

Craft Time with Miss Crystal - Come to this fun filled class that will be lots of fun creating crafts. Your child will design, create, and enjoy making crafts.

Developmental Activities - This class begins with circle time where we sing favorite songs like 'Itsy Bitsy Spider' and 'Wheels on the Bus.' After circle time we enjoy several play activities which foster development in varying combinations of the following: development of fine or gross motor skills, transitioning, taking turns, sharing, and imaginative play. Class ends with parachute activities, bubbles and a goodbye song.

Family Day at the Park- The weather is nice and the time is now! Let's get some fresh air and enjoy our morning outdoors at the park. We will have circle time, kids can enjoy gross motor fun, play with friends, and parents can socialize. Parents are welcome to bring food we will have a sign-up sheet for our snack/lunch time at the park!! Don't miss out on this fun day at the park! Family Story Time and Activities- Reading to your child at an early age is one essential gift that will prepare them for a great start in learning. Families can take this opportunity to get cozy and comfy in our center and read to and with their little ones. There will be activities for families to participate in with their little ones.

Fun In the Sun- Bring your child to this fun filled class that will deal with the sunshine. We will be doing many developmental activities, singing songs, and making crafts related to having fun in the sun. We will be playing in the water and sand sensory bins and tossing balls in the air!! Let's have fun while the sun is out!. This class will be led by Cambria and Crystal.

F2F Social Studies Fun- Let's learn about where we are from. Children will have opportunity to make craft and share during circle about where they are from. And parents will share some cultural traditions and song. This class will be led by F2F.

Game Fun- Come out families and enjoy a time of playing different games with your children. Your children will learn how to take turns playing games with other children and have fun socializing. This class will be led by Crystal .

Jump, Jump, Jump - This class is designed for toddlers who are already walking. The purpose of the class is to provide opportunity for physical activity and fun which promotes large muscle development and exercises coordination and balance. **PARENT PARTICIPATION AND CLOSE SUPERVISION IS MANDATORY FOR THIS CLASS!!!**

Learning Fun with The Children's Cabinet- Come join us to have fun with your little ones and be engaged in fun and developmentally appropriate activities. This hands on informational class will offer some activities to help facilitate pre-kindergarten skills at home. Each class will be unique and cover a different theme. This class will be led by Carolina Cajica with the Children's Cabinet.

Let's Make Music-Come join Miss Cam as we sing, dance, and get creative making our own musical instruments!!

Learning about Feelings" Happy and Sad"- Do you know what makes Mommy and Daddy Happy? Or Sad? Let's come together to show and tell different things that make our mommy and daddy's Happy and what makes them Sad. Come ready to make a creative craft so your children remember how to you smile mom and dad. This class will be led by Mrs Crystal.

Learning to Sequence- Children will learn to make and follow patterns, place objects in chronological order and be asked to demonstrate understanding of putting things in sequential order.

Mix Match Day- Let's have some fun... Come out in your craziness Mix Match Outfit. Bring your children in whatever they choose to wear and however they want their hair. This is crazy fun day. You will get to take a picture with your child that will be printed 2 days after classes and can be picked up at the center along with making a Crazy craft. This class will be led by Mrs Crystal.

Mother's Day Craft Time with Mireya - Come to this fun filled class that will be lots of fun creating crafts for Mother's Day. Your child will design, create, and enjoy making crafts prepared by our parent volunteer Mireya.

Play, Learn & Grow- This class will be lots of great family fun for ages Newborn-Age 5... We will have a fun craft and other fun developmental activities for toddlers to do.. And you can bring your baby and diaper bag packed with a blanket so your little one can enjoy some tummy time, pre-walking, and socialization fun with other moms and their little ones... Class led by F2F staff.

Please and Thank you- there called the magic words. Each day our children learn something new. This class will not only get to teach children to use their words but also remember to say Please and Thank-you. Children and parents will get to demonstrate with their child how they remind their children and get to make a craft. This class will be led by Mrs Crystal.

Pre K Readiness - Early learning and literacy is a key and much needed component to every child's start of education. This is an hour long class that will introduce and review the basics in Pre-K and Kindergarten. We will work on writing and recognizing our colors, shapes, letters, learning sounds, writing numbers, and learning beginning math concepts, number recognition, as well as focusing on development of fine motor, self-help and social/emotional skills. We will have related stories and crafts that will be in relation to lesson/theme focused on the week/month. The structure of the class will vary week by week depending on what we are doing and learning about. This class will be led by Miss. Cam
