




















March Class Descriptions

Aerobic Fun for Kids- Let's get our hearts pumping and move to the beat!!! We will get fit with our F2F friends through this parent and child activity class that will be fun and help your little ones be happy to be fit. This class will be led by Cambria.

Ages & Stages- These are questionnaires that give an effective and affordable way to systematically screen infants and young children for developmental and social-emotional delays in the crucial early years of life. Come and learn some of the age-appropriate skills you can introduce to your child. Call 870-9583 to schedule your session.

Ask a Pediatrician from UNLV School of Medicine - A Children's Health topic will be presented from a Pediatric Resident Physician from the University of Nevada Las Vegas-School of Medicine. Topics change each week and covers a range of issues including Child Car Seats, Nutrition, Obesity, Vaccines, Breastfeeding, Smoking Dangers, and much more. The presentation will be followed by a brief Q&A session where you can ask the Pediatrician any questions about their presentation or anything else about your child's health.

Ask Theatre Presents "Fairyland"-Fairyland is an interactive story linked to Ireland Play Duration 35/40 mins Age 3+. Meet the happy community of Fairyland, where fairies live, learn, work, and play together... Until one day when Divina, the witch shows up. Her intentions are not the best.. and the fairies need to do something about this. Learning outcomes: community building, roles of community members, anti-bullying, communication and collaboration. This performance will be given by Ask Theater.

Butterflies Come Alive- The life cycle of butterflies is fascinating sight to see. Children will get to explore the 4 different stages butterflies go through. Over the course of 3 weeks Children will get to watch as butterflies go through the life cycle process. In this class children will get to socialize by talking about what they see, use predication on what they believe will happen and take home a craft using their creative imagination each week. This class will be led by Miss Crystal and Miss Stephanie.

Busy Parents on the Move- Being a parent is not always easy. However, we find ways to make everything work out just fine. In this class we will develop topics of interest and struggle to discuss. We will share with other parents; learn new things, gain new resources, ideas, and strategies to help us continue to manage all we do. This discussion group will be led by Miss Cam.

Dancing with Miss Jenny® - Dancing With Miss Jenny® is a creative movement program designed to aid preschool aged children with and without disabilities achieve developmental milestones. Miss Jenny's concepts are a fusion of early childhood education, dance, and creative movement concepts choreographed to strengthen physical and mental advancements in young children. Common household and classroom items such as paper plates and plastic spoons are incorporated into the choreography to assist in bringing out the desired movements of the child, as well as provide a novel way to maintain their attention. Each piece of choreography targets a combination of developmental benchmarks such as gross and fine motor skills, sensory, cognitive, language and social skills.

Developmental Activities - This class begins with circle time where we sing favorite songs like 'Itsy Bitsy Spider' and 'Wheels on the Bus.' After circle time we enjoy several play activities which foster development in varying combinations of the following: development of fine or gross motor skills, transitioning, taking turns, sharing, and imaginative play. Class ends with parachute activities, bubbles and a goodbye song.

Dr. Seuss Day: Thing One and Thing Two - Join F2F staff as we celebrate Read Across America Day with Dr. Seuss inspired activities. During the first hour we will practice gross and fine motor skills and prep snack. The second hour will focus on arts and craft activities.

Family yoga- Strengthen family bonds and create togetherness with family yoga. Join us for a fun series of poses that teach communication skills, confidence and trust and ends in a sitting relaxation. This class is taught by Miss Stephanie.

Fee-fi-fo-fum- Come have some fun with Jack and the Beanstalk. There is nothing like hearing and old English tale Fairy Tale. Children will have fun hearing a story about Jack, while playing fairy tale dressing up, looking and touching different types of beans along with creating their take come craft. This class will be led by Miss Crystal.

Fine Motor Fun with Sorting!-Join us for a fun filled hour of matching and sorting while having fun with the concepts of same and different and problem solving with manipulatives to engage children through play while working on fine motor skills. This class will be led by Miss Stefanae.

Game Fun- Come out Families and enjoy a time of playing different games with your children. Your children learn how to take turns playing games with other children and have fun socializing. This class will be led by Miss. Crystal.

Hidden Figures-Let's explore Outer Space and Katherine Coleman Goble Johnson who is an African-American mathematician who worked as a NASA aeronautical engineer and served as the brains behind the flight path for the first American mission launched into space. Activities to follow. This class will be led by Miss Stefanae the children will learn vocabulary: Moon, sun, stars, space, earth, astronaut, and build a space mobile.

It's Spring Time- Come out to learn about the amazing season of Spring. We will do crafts and activities while learning about key elements that happen in our environment during spring time. This class will be led by our UNLV Intern Angela Rivera.

Learning Fun with The Children's Cabinet - Come join us to have fun with your little ones and be engaged in fun and developmentally appropriate activities. This hands-on informational class will offer some activities to help facilitate pre-kindergarten skills at home. Each class will be unique and cover a different theme. This class will be led by Amanda Harding with the Children's Cabinet.

March is Women's History Month- Celebrate Women's history month learning about the pioneering spirit of Amelia Earhart, the first female aviator to fly solo across the Atlantic Ocean. Taught by Miss Stephanie.

Monkey See, Monkey Do - Children learn through example. You are your child's first teacher. Enjoy a monkey themed day along side your Pre-K student engaging in literacy, math, dramatic play, and sensory activities. This class is taught by Miss Stephanie.

MUNCH, MUNCH, MUNCH- Come join us for story time as we read an all-time classic "The Very Hungry Caterpillar". Color matching, food identification, and counting activities to follow story time. This class will be led by Miss Stefanae.

Nursery Rhyme- Hey Friends it's time to learn some more nursey rhymes. Are you ready to hear Mary, Quite Contrary? Friends will get to make a craft and enjoy listening to Mary. This class will be led by Miss Crystal.

Old McDonald's Farm- Join us to learn about the different farm animals. We will create fun animal crafts while learning about their unique characteristics. In this class children will have the opportunity to play and explore the animal's farm environment while singing, practicing math and literacy. This class will be led by our UNLV Intern Angela Rivera.

Pre K Readiness - Early learning and literacy is a key and much needed component to every child's start of education. This is an hour long class that will introduce and review the basics in Pre-K and Kindergarten. We will work on writing and recognizing our colors, shapes, letters, learning sounds, writing numbers, and learning beginning math concepts, number recognition, as well as focusing on development of fine motor, self-help and social/emotional skills. We will have related stories and crafts that will be in relation to lesson/theme focused on the week/month. The structure of the class will vary week by week depending on what we are doing and learning about. This class will be led by Miss. Cam

Rainbows- Join us in water color fun as we paint with various materials and learn how our primary colors mix to make secondary colors. This class will be led by Miss Stefanae.

School Bus Fun- Join us to learn about shapes and basic traffic signs. This is a great way to make children aware of their surrounding while walking in the street or riding in the car. During this class children will have opportunity to play games, make crafts, sing songs all while learning something new. This class will be led by our UNLV Intern Angela Rivera.

Sensory Fun Explorations- Bring your toddler to this fun class in which they will have opportunity to explore, learn and feel textures and different sensory materials. We will become in touch with our senses while having fun exploring many different things we commonly see and feel in our everyday environments. We will have circle time and other activities to engage children through play while working on sensory exploration. This class will be led by Cambria

Sight Word Fun- Friends let's continue to grow our vocabulary as we review the sight words we have already learned. Re-read the words with your children they have learned; The, See, No, In, Out, You and Me. Get ready to learn the new words; Can and I. Children will practice tracing their name and recognize letters. This class will be led by Miss Crystal.

Sign Language with Cheryl- Join our parent volunteer Cheryl as she introduces and reviews basic and beginner sign language. The class will be interactive and engaging.

Snack Time - We will provide your child with a snack to enjoy while they visit with other Family to Family friends. Parents can also feel free to bring your own snack during this time. All donations are appreciated.

St. Patrick's Day Shape Fun! -Sign up for this fun class reviewing numbers and shapes we will count shamrocks and turn hearts into shamrocks and numbers. Children will go on a shape hunt, Cut and paste and glue art and math activity. This class will be led by Miss Stefanae.

The Jungle adventure- Come out to experience one day in the jungle. This class will be filled with different crafts activities where children will learn about animals that live in the jungle though mathematics, literacy and fine motor skills. This class will be led by our UNLV Intern Angela Rivera.

Three Square Presents; Cooking Matters at the Store- Want to save money at the store? Want to buy healthy foods for your family? Need some tasty and healthy recipes? This class will be a grocery store workshop teaching skills for buying healthy foods on a budget. Led by Three Square.

Yoga and Early Literacy with Joanna - Join Ms. Joanna from NEIS as she leads families through Yoga exercises and introduces and reviews early literacy activities for your child.

1 Book, 2 Book, Red Book, Blue Book- Reading books aloud and playing with language help create strong literacy skills. Dr. Seuss books are great for reading aloud. Hear the playful language and rhymes of his books and play games in honor of Dr. Seuss's birthday. Taught by Miss Stephanie

1-2-3, Count With Me- The basic foundation of math is understanding numbers and quantities. One of the best ways to develop these understandings, or number sense, is through handling objects and counting them. Join us for some hands on counting fun through games, songs, and learning centers. Taught by Miss Stephanie.
